Good News Translation (GNT) Luke 20: 27 -40

Marriage / Resurrection

27 Then some Sadducees, who say that people will not rise from death, came to Jesus and said, 28 "Teacher, Moses wrote this law for us: "If a man dies and leaves a wife but no children, that man's brother must marry the widow so that they can have children who will be considered the dead man's children.' 29 Once there were seven brothers; the oldest got married and died without having children

30 Then the second one married the woman, 31 and then the third. The same thing happened to all seven - they died without having children. 32 Last of all, the woman died. 33 Now, on the day when the dead rise to life, whose wife will she be? All seven of them had married her."
