Luke 8:40-56

41 Then a man named Jairus arrived; he was an official in the local synagogue. He threw himself down at Jesus' feet and begged him to go to his home, **42** because his only daughter, who was twelve years old, was dying.

As Jesus went along, the people were crowding him from every side. **43** Among them was a woman who had suffered from severe bleeding for twelve years; she had spent all she had on doctors, but no one had been able to cure her. **44** She came up in the crowd behind Jesus and touched the edge of his cloak, and her bleeding stopped at once. **45** Jesus asked, "Who touched me?"

47 The woman saw that she had been found out, so she came trembling and threw herself at Jesus' feet. There in front of everybody, she told him why she had touched him and how she had been healed at once. **48** Jesus said to her, "My daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in peace."

50 But Jesus heard it and said to Jairus, "Don't be afraid; only believe, and she will be well.

53 They all made fun of him, because they knew that she was dead. **54** But Jesus took her by the hand and called out, "Get up, child!" **55** Her life returned, and she got up at once, and Jesus ordered them to give her something to eat. **56** Her parents were astounded, but Jesus commanded them not to tell anyone what had happened.
